- Sleeping bag, pillow, blanket or bedding (for a twin size bed).

- Something warm for cool, summer ocean breezes (light jacket or sweatshirt) and for colder weather (hat, gloves, and coat).
- Casual clothing (for worship service).
- Patience (for your turn in the shower).
- Personal and hygiene items.

- Sunscreen, sunglasses and sandals - both sun and sand get hot and bright.

- SEVERAL TOWELS (sorry no washer or dryer). Laundromats located at 64th St. (going south on Coastal Hwy.) and between 142nd & 143rd Sts. (going north on Coastal Hwy.)
- White vinegar & water spray or a meat tenderizer just in case those nasty sea nettles come to shore. If you plan to visit Assateague Island, bring insect repellent.
- Food & drinks can be purchased at Food Lion (north of the church). PAPER PRODUCTS (paper towels and toilet paper), EATING UTENSILS, COOKWARE, COOKING UTENSILS AND CLEANING SUPPLIES ARE PROVIDED.
